Novice Scrimmage

Academy of Aerospace and Engineering, Greenwich High School September 28, 2019

The CDA's tenth annual Novice Scrimmage will be held on September 28, 2019, at the Academy of Aerospace and Engineering in Windsor and Greenwich High School. It will consist of a demonstration debate between experienced CDA Varsity teams, a preparation period, and two rounds of debate. The preparation period will be split, with time before the demonstration round to review the resolution and read the packet, and time after the demonstration round to complete case preparation. The two rounds of debate will permit each Novice team to debate once as Affirmative and once as Negative. The detailed schedule is at the end of this note. We expect to finish by 3:30PM, about two hours earlier than a regular tournament.

We will be collecting registrations through tabroom.com (www.tabroom.com) as with our regular tournaments. Registration opens Tuesday, September 17 at 8AM. Tabroom is pretty easy to use, but we provide some instructions to guide you through the process. If you have problems, you should email us for help.

Registration Procedure

We have set up three events:

- **Novice** for novices who will debate. These should be two-person teams. See eligibility requirements below.
- **Observer** for students who will simply observe. You must register observers if you want them to get a copy of the resolution packet.
- Varsity Judges for varsity debaters who will judge. Do not enter your Varsity debaters who will
 judges in the judge groups as they will not be judging again this year and it will complicate your
 later tournament registrations.

Debaters cannot attend individually. Each school's students must be accompanied by a responsible adult and follow their own school's rules regarding attendance at interscholastic events. Tabroom will require you to enter that person's name and cell phone number (cell phone numbers will not be used other than in an emergency on the tournament day). The coach/adult must have emergency contact information for all students on the team, including students judging or observing.

Novice Eligibility: The Novice division is primarily for students starting debate in the CDA this year. Second year novices may debate if they need a tune-up before the season starts, but most debaters will be beginners and they should consider whether this is a good use of their time. Juniors may only debate if they have never debated before. Seniors, even if they are new to debate, are not eligible to debate in the Novice Scrimmage, though they may attend as observers.

Judges: Schools must bring one judge for every four debaters, plus one extra. For this scrimmage, experienced Varsity debaters may serve as judges! Student-judges should those be planning to debate at the Varsity level for the upcoming 2019-20 season, Juniors and Seniors preferred. Since we expect all judges will be students, the Judges Workshop will be oriented toward teaching the Varsity debaters about judging. In order to make sure all Varsity debaters who attend get a chance to judge, we may in some cases assign multiple judges per round if we have more judges than required. You may bring extra Varsity debaters if they would like to attend.

Schools new to CDA without Varsity debaters are not required to bring judges. We should be able to cover you with Varsity debaters from other schools.

Awards: None! We will be scoring the debates and returning ballots with comments, but we will not be awarding trophies.

Food: There will be donuts, juice and coffee at registration. Students may purchase pizza and soft drinks for lunch as at our regular tournaments.
